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II. SCIENTIFIC PROFILE

As a faculty member in the field of "Innovation Management", my research interests focus on the strategic management of scientific and technological knowledge and innovation both at the micro-level (enterprises) and at the macro-level, in institutions responsible for the formulation and implementation of research policy at national and regional level. In this context, I have conducted research technological and scientific knowledge flows between firms, on knowledge diffusion and transfer at national and regional level and on the use of new technologies in the development of innovative entrepreneurship. I have gained significant research experience as a project leader and/or project team member in national and European research projects

My authorial work includes more than 65 scientific publications in books, book chapters, articles in scientific journals and conference proceedings as well as scientific studies in the above areas.

My teaching work includes teaching a variety of undergraduate and postgraduate courses at the University of Athens. I am responsible for the establishment and operation of the English language MSc in Innovation Management and Entrepreneurship at the Hellenic Open University (Hellenic Open University) and in joint MSc courses of other institutions (NTUA, PAPEI) as well as the academic responsibility for the establishment and operation of the English language MSc in Innovation Management and Entrepreneurship of the Hellenic Open University. In the framework of my participation in the Erasmus mobility programme+ , I have visited as a Visiting Professor similar departments in universities abroad (Aalto University (Finland), Technische Hochschule Ingolstadt (Germany), University of Konstanz (Germany), MRU (Lithuania) and I have given lectures on subjects of my scientific interests.

During my tenure as a faculty member in the Department of Economics and Management Engineering, I have collaborated with both fellow faculty members of the

Department from the field of Natural Sciences, as well as with colleagues from other universities in Greece and abroad, in activities that have led to published work.

I am co-founder (together with my colleague G. Liagouras) of the institutionalized Laboratory of "Applied Economics and Technology Studies Laboratory", "Econ-Tech Lab", at the Department of Economics and Management Engineering (TMOD) of the University of the Aegean (Government Gazette: Issue B' 4323/24). The laboratory serves educational and research needs in the fields of Economics and Management, Technology-Innovation-Entrepreneurship and Regional Development. In particular, it is mainly active in research activities in the fields of

- Strategic Management of Technology-Innovation (with emphasis on the digital economy).
- Socio-economic Technology and Development (with emphasis on the digital economy and the less developed regions of the EU).
- Applications of Quantitative Methods in Economics and Management, with emphasis on the above two areas (Strategic Management of Technology-Innovation and Socio-Economics of Technology and Development).

I have served as Vice President (2020-2022) and President (2022-2025) at the Department of Economics and Management Engineering of the University of Athens. I have served the Department, the Faculty of Engineering and the Foundation in various administrative positions and responsibilities (Member of the 7-member management body of the Research Committee of the University of Athens, from 2022 to 2022). Aegean, Member of the extended Research Committee, Member of Erasmus+ Committee, Member of the Senate, etc.).

A) Research, Writing, Teaching, and Administrative work after election to the rank of Associate Professor. Professor

My research activity since 2014, when I became Associate Professor, focused mainly on the following areas of interest:

- the analysis and empirical investigation of the importance and role of innovation in the public sector,
- innovation and entrepreneurship in the creative industries and the role of digital platforms in them,
- exploring the methods and scope for developing dynamic competences in the public sector in the context of the Smart Specialisation Strategy, and
- the role of universities in the dissemination and management of scientific and technological knowledge and innovation at regional level.

Specifically, in the context of the cooperation and supervision of the PhD thesis of Dr. D. thesis, which was completed in January 2022, I collaborated with him in the evaluation of the public sector reforms introduced through the Operational Programme Administrative Reform 2007-2013. This work examined a large number of co-funded administrative reform programmes (417) and was based on data collected from the Operational Programme databases that helped to derive a set of indicators on the economic and physical activity of the programme. The analysis of these data provided interesting results on the types of reform projects, their degree of innovation and their correlation with a number of economic indicators, but most importantly with the degree

of completion within the established timeframes. Results of this cooperation have been presented at international conferences (EAEPE, Globelics) and an article has been submitted and is currently under review in the international journal *South European Society and Politics*.

In the context of my collaboration with the postgraduate students P. Stavrianidis, V. V. Professor N. Mylonas from Ionian University, we started a research effort that seeks to explore the role of digital platforms as innovative tools in the reconfiguration of micro-enterprise activities of creative people (artists, creators, craftsmen). The creative industries are among the least explored sectors in terms of their participation in the technological revolution of digital platforms. Etsy is the leading and best known among these platforms, but there are other equally interesting web-enabled platforms operating at regional, national or international level. As a first step, we identified several types of digital platforms designed to meet the needs of creators. By collecting information through their websites and analysing their content, scope and structure, we proceeded to classify digital platforms for creators using tools from the business models literature, thus contributing to the discussion on the role of digital platforms for creators from a methodological and empirical point of view. In the next stage, we investigated through field research the factors that influence the adoption and impact of digital platforms on Greek creators active in the creative industries using the theoretical framework of Technological, Economic and Environmental Factors (TOE Framework). The results of the research are revealing regarding the impact of the Covid-19 crisis on creative activity and highlight the key parameters that contribute to the adoption of online platforms. The results of this research effort have been presented at 3 international conferences (5th International Conference of Development and Economy (ICODECON) 2022, International Association for the Development of Information Systems (IADIS) Conference 2022, European Forum for Studies of Policies for Research and Innovation (EU-SPRI Conference) 2023) and a research paper is in progress to be submitted to the journal *Congent Business and Management*.

In the context of the cooperation and supervision of the doctoral thesis of the Candidate. D. student Ms. Tharwat Jaber at Frederick University Cyprus which was successfully completed in May 2024, it was investigated whether and how public sector organizations develop dynamic capabilities, transferring the framework and the problematic that has been developed in the field of strategic innovation management regarding the development of dynamic capabilities at the firm level in public sector organizations. To this end, the Smart Specialisation strategy framework was used as a case study, and by combining it with the literature on dynamic capabilities a conceptual framework was formulated to investigate whether and to what extent public sector organisations that were asked to implement and manage the Smart Specialisation strategy developed dynamic capabilities. Results of this work have been presented at international conferences (EAEPE, 2019; EUROPEAN WEEK OF REGIONS AND CITIES 2019? RSA Research Network on EU Cohesion Policy Workshop *Building Administrative Capacities for Cohesion Policy Public*, 2019 (at the invitation of the organisers to the HR)) and a scientific article has been submitted and is currently under review in the *Journal of the Knowledge Economy*.

In the context of my involvement as coordinator of Action 1.4 entitled "*Electronic research infrastructure for the collection and processing of data on the research, development and innovation footprint of the Greek regions: Patent & R&D Excellence [e-Aegean R&D Excellence] patenting tools & indicators*" of the "Regional Excellence" institutional research project, a research

team was formed by faculty members of the Department of Economics and Management Engineering and two postdoctoral researchers. The team worked on the collection, processing and analysis of bibliographic data on scientific publications from institutions of the North and South Aegean Regions using different scientific databases over time (Scopus, Web of Science) and data on patents from the North and South Aegean Regions. The results of this collaboration contributed to the debate that has developed in the international literature on the research impact of regional universities on local and regional innovation and entrepreneurship, were presented international conferences (EBEEC, 2023 and Eu-SPRI 2023) and led to the publication of an article in the journal Science and Public Policy.

Also, in the framework of the same Foundation research project "Regional Excellence" as a member of Action 1.8 "Innovate & Business", the research team in which I participated, consisting of Candidate. The research team, under the supervision of the PhD Ms. Eleni Zarimi and her supervisor, faculty member Mr. Liagouras, dealt with the issue of the development role of universities in the less developed regions of a region, the so-called third-tier regions, mainly through the preservation of human capital and the reduction of brain-drain. The results of this effort (a) were presented at the international conference EBEEC, (b) led to the publication in the journal European Planning Studies - which was accepted for publication with minor revisions - and (c) fed the submission of a research proposal to the EUROPEAN ECONOMIC HORIZON (EEA) FUNDING MECHANISM 2014-2021 entitled "*Regional Universities as Catalysts for Economic Development: Their Role in Enhancing Knowledge, Innovation, and Graduate Employment*" in collaboration with Western Norway University of Applied Sciences. According to a recent update from the EEA Project Management Body, our proposal received a positive evaluation is to be formally approved for implementation within January 2025.

During the period 2015-2017 I participated as a partner in the European research project CREA funded by the HORIZON 2020 programme (<https://cordis.europa.eu/project/id/644988>), leading the research team of the University of the Aegean. The CREA project aimed to research and organize training, mentoring and incubation activities for start-ups in the field of Creative Industries. The result of this engagement was the operation of a Summer School of Entrepreneurship for young creators and the writing and presentation of an article at the international CUMULUS Hong Kong 2016 Conference.

Since 2017 I am a member of the Scientific Board of the journal Electronic Markets (Springer Verlag), then I became Associate Editor and since 2023 I am Senior Editor of the same journal.

Also, in the context of my long-standing cooperation with the Hellenic Open University, in 2020 I took the initiative and contributed greatly to the establishment and operation of the English-language MSc in Innovation Management and Entrepreneurship of the Hellenic Open University, which I have been directing since its launch in 2022 until today.

Finally, regarding my contribution to administrative work, in the period 2020-2022 I served as Vice President of the Department of Economics and Management Engineering and in the period 2022-2025 I assumed the position of the Chair of the Department. During my term as Vice President, I contributed significantly to the accreditation process of the Department's Undergraduate Curriculum (POC) by the National Authority for

Higher Education (NAHE) where it was assessed with the highest grade of full compliance with the principles of the Quality Standard, while during my term as President, the Department was further developed with four additional new faculty members

In the project I am participating as the project leader. Responsible for the Pan. Aegean. The CREA project is funded by the European Commission's ***Horizon 2020 Programme*** and aims to promote creativity and development through ICT to produce structural changes and specific regulations in the European business base and to influence future social change and innovation in Europe. The CREA project seeks to establish a new European model of Summer Academies for students who want to develop business ideas focused on creativity and ICT and explore innovation in areas such as: new products for new markets, social innovation, boosting innovation in traditional sectors, innovation in services, knowledge and technology-based innovation, etc. The CREA project will implement two editions of the Summer Academy which will be organised simultaneously in 7 European cities (Milan, Stuttgart, Ljubljana, Newcastle, Tallinn, Utrecht, Syros), and which will conclude with an international event (CREA International ICT Business Idea Competition) to present the results to international investors and award a prize.
